


#### Lilly Pilly 4

My favourite thing about Christie Downs is going on excursions and reading my books. Next year I will miss my teachers, Spanish and my friends.




My favourite thing about Christie Downs is the courtyard and the ball pit. Next year I will miss my friends and my teachers.


To finish the year the upper primary classes are participating in a camp where they will set up tents, cook, complete various challenges and fun activities.
